PLANNING

Planning Applications received in respect of:

Halfboys, Ixworth Road, Norton for erection of garage and creation of new vehicular access – ref 1564/17. Although the Parish Council had no objection to this application, they had concerns as to whether there was sufficient turning space on site for vehicles, and sufficient visibility splay.

Hayfield House, Ashfield Road, Norton for erection of 2 bay cartlodge – ref 1826/17. The Council offered objection to this application.

The size of the cartlodge appeared disproportionate to the size of the plot and house.

GP1 – The design and layout of the proposed cartlodge does not respect the appearance of the surrounding area by means of size and scale.

There was insufficient vehicle turning space on site, and lack of sufficient off-road parking.

T10 - Safe access to and egress from the site and highway safety.

1 – 8 School Close, Norton for change of use from former sheltered accommodation common room to local authority office use – ref DC/17/02636. The Parish Council had concern about parking that continues to be an issue in School Close, particularly with school buses using the Close.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr.Aket read an email received concerning use of the playingfield to access school grounds for additional building work. This item will be placed on the next agenda.
