## **PLANNING**

Planning Applications received in respect of

Halls Farm, Halls Lane, Norton for listed building consent for works to facilitate change of use of barn to domestic use including alteration, erection of two storey extension and a detached cartlodge (Ref DC/18/02047). The Council supported this proposal in order to maintain the listed barn. They requested the barn is kept as one unit and the recommendations of the Heritage appraisal are taken into consideration.

Warren Cottage, Ixworth Road, Norton for erection of single storey side/rear extension (DC/18/02021). The Council had no objection to this proposal but commented that it is important to maintain off road parking for at least two vehicles at the property.

Little Haugh Hall, Ixworth Road, Norton, for change of use of land for the stationing of 10 holiday lodges (DC/18/01667). The Council had the following comments to make on this application:

- The access and egress at the A1088 will be compromised due to the additional movement from service vehicles and holiday makers, so the entrance visibility splay needs to be widened.
- The lodges need to be sympathetic to the area, particularly regarding noise and lighting of the area.
- Condition should be imposed to ensure the lodges are for holiday let only, and do not become permanent residences.
